### Spirit Sticks!



Wow! What success we had in the inaugural year of the Spirit Stick program at PSE!

Good habits should be recognized and our Spirit Stick program will help do just that! Participation is completely optional, and this is NOT a fundraiser. The goal of this program is to help develop a sense of community at PSE among the students and staff – fostering positive attitudes and encouraging great behavior and dedicated students.

There are three ways a child can get Spirit Sticks. Seasonal and fun type Spirit Sticks will be available for sale twice a month (at the price of \$1 each). Special Spirit Sticks will be given out by PSE staff to recognize students that demonstrate positive behavior, hard work, dedication, leadership or a can do attitude! These special Sticks will not be available for purchase and must be earned. Lastly, students will receive Spirit Sticks during the year from PTO or during PSE's special events. 
